

My Body

We will have a focus on fine motor skills e.g. threading, pinching, cutting and posting amongst other skills which help improve dexterity.

We will also build confidence with gross motor skills by focusing on key aspects such as balance, rolling, throwing and catching.

SRE- We are continuing to look at labelling and pointing to different body parts.

My Technology

We will be engaging and exploring a range of technological devices including sound buttons. We will have a musical link during these sessions and use a variety of games to make sound sequences using familiar cause and effect devices.

Home Learning Ideas

- Using visuals/signs at home to make requests. Please Dojo for anything you might need!
- Exploring sound and different noises familiar objects could make.
- Using technology and music apps to create their own rhythm and beat e.g. Blob Orchestra.

My Imagination

In Music Robin class will look at a selection of sounds and the different objects that can create them. We will use creative expression and exploration through sound, rhythm, and movement.

In Art we will explore a range of methods and materials and explore the sound they make, linking to our music sessions. We will use dripping, splashing and splatting to different rhythms and tempos.

Looking after myself

Robin class will be working on independence and understanding of their own needs and actively engaging in meeting them. Robin class will build on independence in navigating the classroom and asking for what pupils want appropriately.

We will be looking at building relationships with peers, accepting others in our space and playing alongside others. We will continue looking at emotions and being able to label what they are as well as recognising them in others.

My Communication

In our communication sessions we will be focusing on the early conversational elements of communication.

We will look at increasing the duration of in interactions and participation through familiar routines and structures.

Robin class will be looking at making and communicating their own choices and building on this to use the 'I want...' sentence strips to build more complex communication strategies.

My Thinking

Pupils in Robin class will be working on a range of early Literacy, early Maths, Engagement and Motivation and Understanding the World.

We will be looking at a range of mark making activities, fine motor skills and exploring and matching symbols and their meanings.

We will be exploring familiar stories and sounds e.g. birds, cars and matching them with symbols.

We will explore and order numbers and begin to develop understanding of number correspondence.

SRE- We will be looking at wider peers around school and key staff and their names.
