My Communication: In My Communication this half-term, we will be modelling our lessons around the book War dog.

Reading: We will be looking at exposing our pupils to a wider range of texts, as well as focusing on reading for enjoyment and functionality.

Writing: In writing, we will be looking at writing to inform through creating brochures of the school.



My Problem Solving / Maths and Problem Solving

This half-term we will be continuing to focus on the four operations but with a focus on division and splitting numbers into different groups. This will link explicitly to our functional skill unit of work by supporting pupils with timetables used in time and money.

To develop functional skills, we will be looking at using the four operations to support questions around real-life situations such as measuring or dealing with money. We will be exploring how we can use these skills out in the community.

To develop our use of Shape, Space and Measure, we will be looking at a range of shapes including how to measure and check angles.

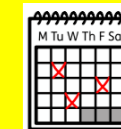

My Health/Healthy Lifestyles

PE- In PE this half term we will be preparing for Sports Day which will be happening this half-term. Within this, we will be looking at different track and field sports, as well as looking at some of the activities that will be coming up at Sports Day so that pupils can make an informed choice over what they would like to choose to do!

Food Tech – In Food Tech, we will be focusing on cleanliness and health and safety, whilst exploring different tastes and textures.



My Independence/Careers and Independence

Careers: In careers, we will be looking into interviews and how to appropriately communicate with employers.

Independence: For our independence, we will be linking closely with our PSHCE unit of work thinking about risks within the community, and how we can independently access the community around Southgate.



Home Learning Opportunities

Learning about the body – Why walking keeps your body healthy. Whilst walking, practice marching at different speeds, slow, medium and fast

Maths - On your walk, estimate how many steps, then count them, to reach a target in the distance.

Reading – to share with your child based on their interests.

Independence – As the days get longer, take walks in nature and get your child to discuss how the landscape may have changed since WW1.
